LIVESTOCK

New this year - All market animals for Fair, including backup animals, must be tagged during inspections. Tag numbers must be recorded on the Market Animal Inspection forms. General/project leaders can pick up tags at the 4-H Office. Market animals that aren't tagged before the August 1st deadline will not be eligible to show at the Fair in the market class. If you need help with tagging animals, contact the Extension Office and we will be happy to find someone who can assist. General/project leaders will need to sign the forms verifying their visual confirmation of the market project animals in their club, including backup animals, and return the forms to the 4-H Office by 4:30 p.m., August 1, 2017. **Once again, market animals that aren't tagged before the August 1st deadline will be not be eligible to show at the Fair in the market class.**

Photography Contest

June 16th is the deadline to turn in your "Nature's Beauty" photograph and entry form.

- This exhibit is open to all Elko County 4-H members ages 9-19.
- Participation is NOT limited to just those 4-H'ers enrolled in photography projects.
- Entrants must submit their photos within the division that applies (Junior 9-10; Intermediate 11-13; Senior 14-19).
- Each entrant may submit only one photo ("Nature's Beauty"). This means that each individual 4-H'er may only have one (1) entry.
- All photos must have been taken by 4-H members between the dates of October 1, 2016 and the entry date, June 16, 2017.
- Please attach an entry form to the photo.
- Photos may be in color OR black-and-white.
- No computer enhanced photos will be allowed.
- All entries must be entered in a photo matte- but not a frame. The overall photo size will be between 5" x 7" and not larger than 8" x 12"

Entries will be accepted by mail, as long as they are postmarked by June 16, 2017 and include an entry form. There is a \$5 entry fee.

If you have items you would like to consign to the Livestock and Tack Sale, it should be gently used, clean, in working order with the price marked clearly. Livestock must be sound and the seller must have proper paperwork to transfer ownership. Items can be dropped off the afternoon before the sale, June 23 between Noon and 3 p.m., or between 8-9 a.m. on Sale Day, at the Home Arts Building, Fairgrounds. If you have livestock to sell, check in is at 8 a.m., June 24. Consignees may pick up their money or unsold items between 4-6 p.m. on Saturday, June 24, or you may donate both the proceeds of the sale or the unsold item to the Elko County 4-H Program. A 10% commission will be charged on each item sold.
