## Mobile Technology Lab (MTL)

The Mobile Technology Lab is a set of computers, digital video and still cameras, printers, and associated equipment and software that supports OMK by facilitating communication between deployed military personnel and their families. Children & youth use the MTL to develop personal messages to their deployed parents through a variety of media, including electronic greeting cards, digital photography, and through internet communications.

The MTL is also available for use by OMK partner organizations such as Nevada State 4-H, Boys & Girls Club, National Guard Family Programs Offices, Air Force and Army Family And Youth Services, the Nevada State Department of Education, and the American Legion
