

Nevada 4-H Shooting Sports Club
Safety Checklist for
Firearm Storage and Transportation

For Club equipment and leader use – not intended for member use but smart advice to heed.

6/8/06

Storage

_____Firearms **must** be unloaded

_____Firearms are securely locked in a gun cabinet/vault/safe **OR** securely locked location **OR** location accessible only to certified shooting sports volunteer/leader

Transportation

_____Firearms **must** be unloaded

_____Firearms are locked in a sturdy, opaque container (sturdy gun box) that cannot easily be broken open/into, or accidentally opened during transportation

_____Opaque containers cannot be marked in a way that indicates contents – unless the only marking is a name or address

_____If left in an unattended vehicle (no adult or minor with a minor's license stays with the firearms), firearms **must** be locked in trunk/similar compartment of vehicle; **OR** if vehicle does not have trunk/similar compartment, firearms **must** be out of sight inside the locked vehicle

_____Total number of firearms, types and serial numbers are recorded and in possession of the person transporting the firearms
