# Pesticide Recordkeeping

- **General Use Pesticide**

- *Less likely to harm humans or the environment when it is used according to label directions.*

- **Restricted Use Pesticide**

- *Could cause human injury or environmental damage, unless applied by competent certified applicator.*

# Why keep pesticide use records?

- Helps with management decisions
  - Knowing the amount used helps determine the amount to purchase.





# Why keep pesticide use records?

- Product effectiveness
  - Time of year
  - Weather conditions
  - Rate



# Why keep pesticide use records?

- Liability protection
  - Evidence that pesticides were mixed and applied according to label instructions.



# Why keep pesticide use records?

- Required for “*restricted use*” pesticides
  - 1993 Farm Bill
  - State requirement NAC 555.700

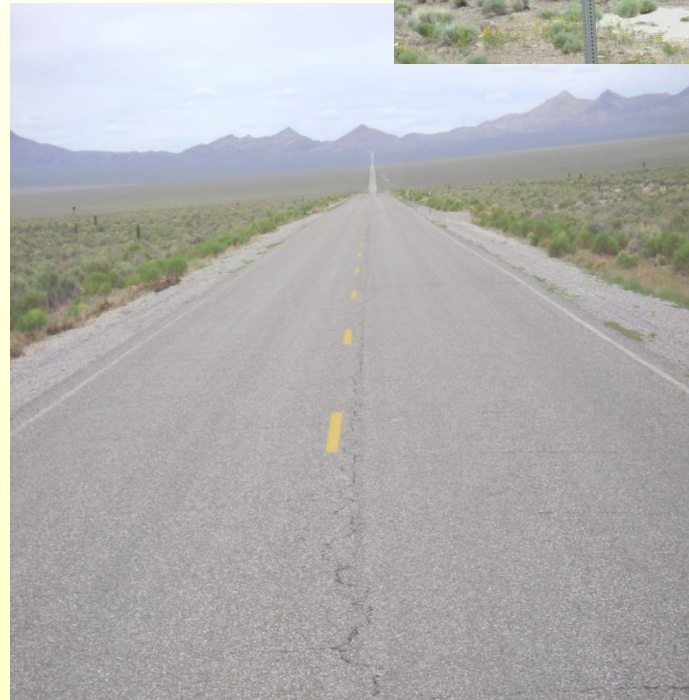
