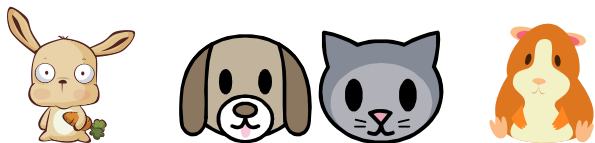

Reminder to 4-H Clubs:

4-H Record Book Workshops Scheduled for 2017:

If you have an interest in completing a 4-H Record Book for 2017, you will have an opportunity to attend workshops from June through October of 2017. The workshops will guide you through the process of how to

put the record book together, what you need to keep for record keeping and help with project sheets. PWH Lego Club:

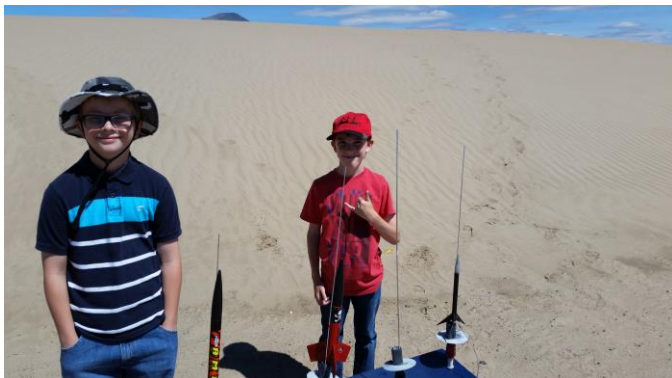

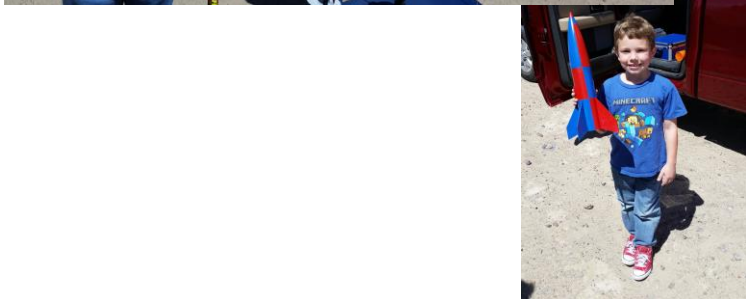
