Humboldt County 4-H Static Fair Entry Results:

4-H youth entered their club projects in the 4-H portion of the Tri-County Fair, September 1-3, 2017. 4-H youth that participate in traditional 4-H clubs such as cooking, crafts, photography, Legos, sewing and various other clubs, work hard all year on their projects. The Tri-County Fair allows 4-H youth to showcase the projects they have worked so hard on throughout the year. 4-H youth are awarded ribbons based on judging results. 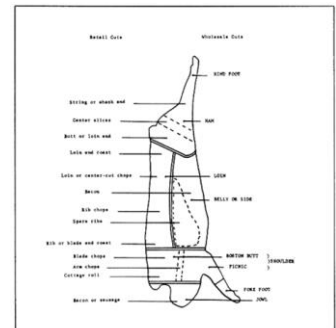
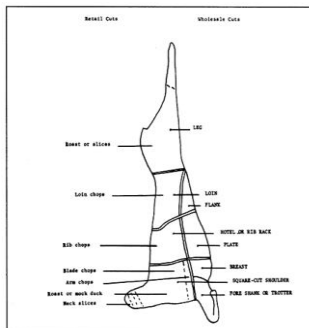
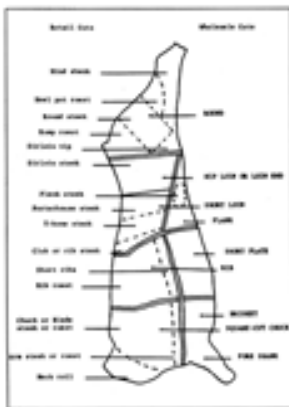
