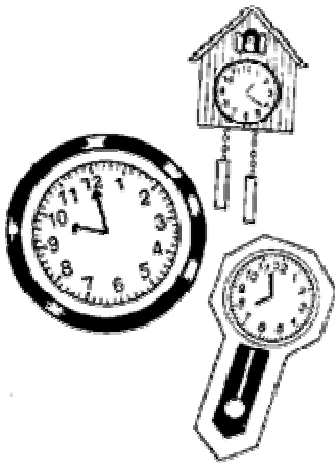

(Traditional, United States)

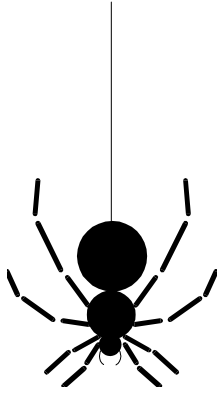
### Hands Upon My Head

My fingers can stand up straight and tall.

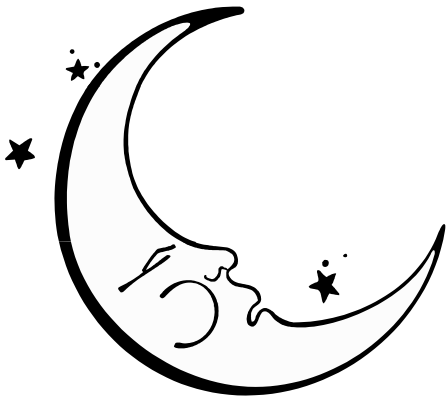
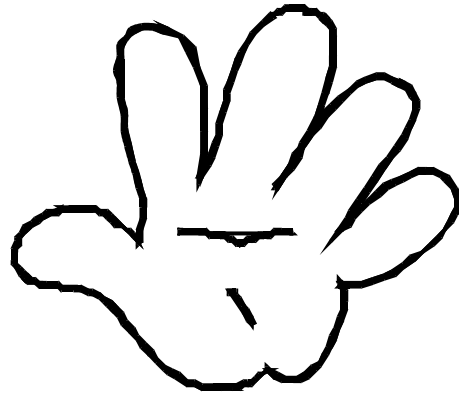
My fingers can bend and be very small.
