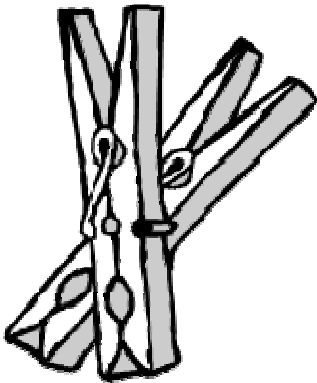

Kitchen Capers Clothes Pins in the Can



An empty coffee can or oatmeal box with a plastic lid makes a good place to store old-fashioned clothes pins. Baby can empty the pins for the container and put them back again. She can shake the can full of clothes pins and hear them rattle. Try cutting a small hole in the lid so she can drop the pins in the can. Older babies can slip old-fashioned clothes pins around the rim of the can.
