Blocks and Boxes Kitchen Capers

Give your baby plastic measuring cups that stack one inside the other, wooden spoons and plastic mixing bowls.

Place a small measuring cup on the floor and cover it with one mixing bowl. Ask your baby to find the cup. Continue this activity until he loses interest. These are all fun and exciting items for baby to play with. They are safe and readily available.
